#### **A) Partnership Agreements**

1. We currently have two CBOs with our IHE and LEA'S who are involved in the planning and implementation of the project. On Appendix V Form 3 it states to list all partner organizations providing services, furthermore, that agencies or organizations which only provide services are considered to be a vendor, not a partner and do not require a partnerships agreement. Is it then correct to assume all other organizations assisting us with the execution of services are considered a vendor and therefore can be listed on this form and do not require partnership agreements? Yes, organizations assisting the lead applicant with only the execution of services are considered a vendor and can be listed on Appendix V, Form 3 and do not require a partnership agreement. If we list a vendor and call them by name in our grant narrative, does that require us to have a partnership agreement with them? No, a partnership agreement is not required for a vendor named in the grant narrative. Notwithstanding the foregoing, applicants are required to submit a partnership agreement with their application consisting of an IHE, LEA, and a not-for profit CBO. See the RFP for the requirements of a partnership.
