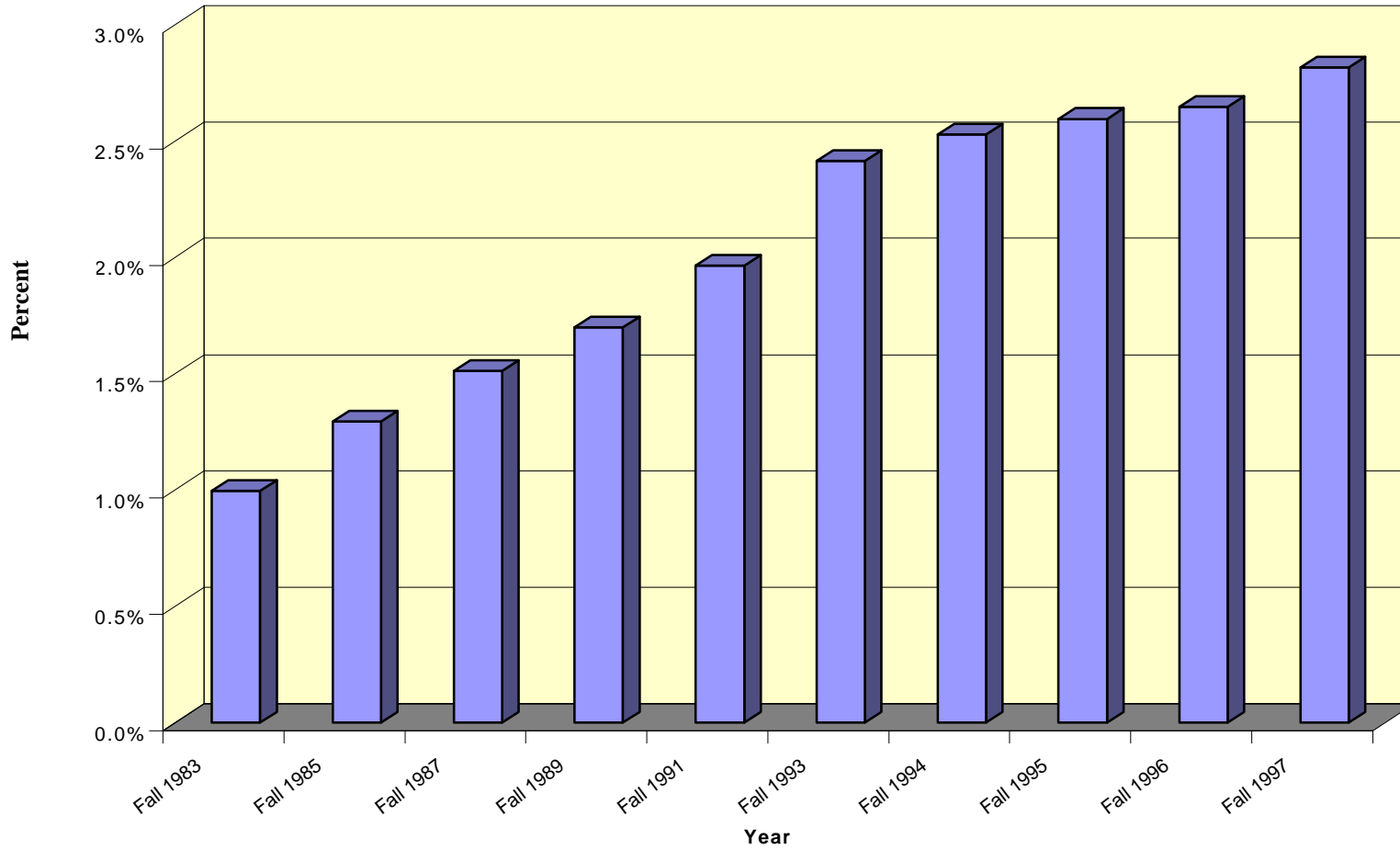

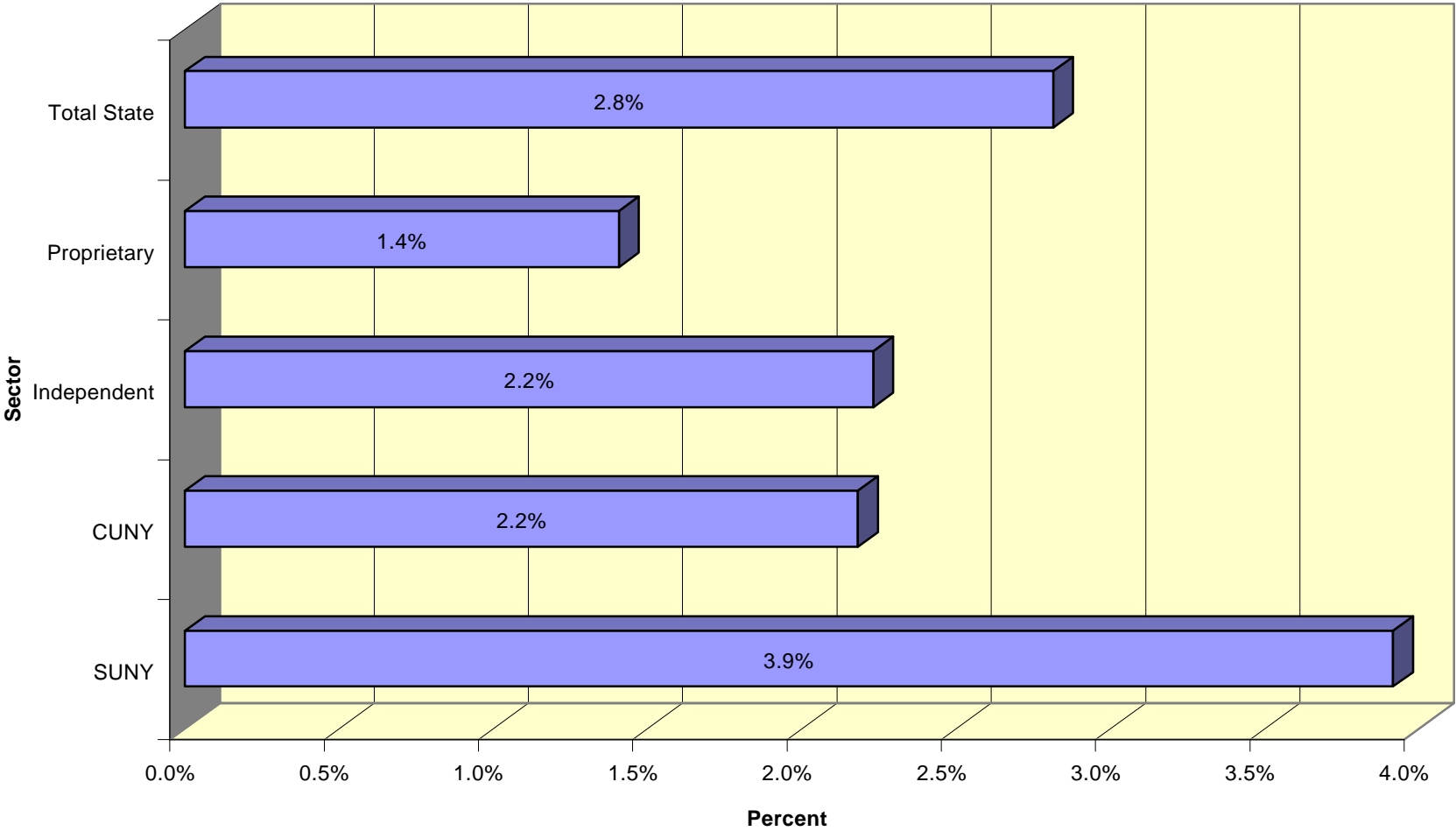

FALL 1983 TO FALL 1997**



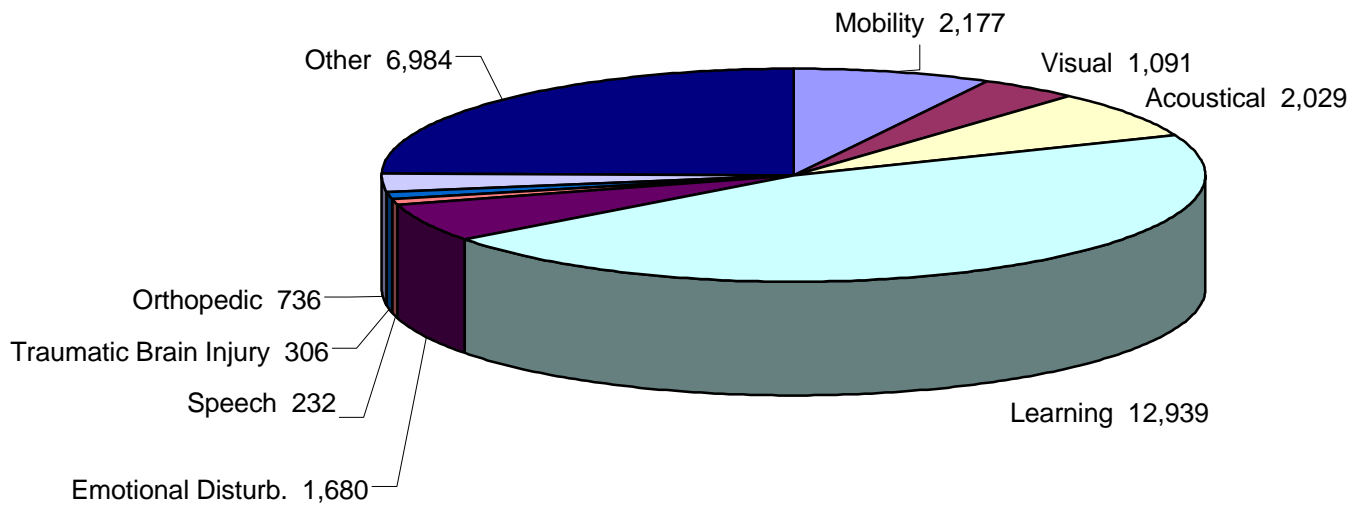
