DEFINITIONS

INSTITUTIONAL UNIVERSE

All degree-credit colleges in New York State under the authority of the University of the State of New York and the Board of Regents. This group includes all public and private colleges except the two federal academies (Merchant Marine Academy and West Point).

SECTORS

Public

SUNY: State University of New York, including the statutory colleges at Cornell and Alfred Universities

CUNY: City University of New York

Private

Independent: Not-for-profit

Proprietary: For-profit

DEGREE-CREDIT ENROLLMENT

Number of students enrolled in courses for credit. Some duplication occurs, with students enrolled in more than one college counted twice.

Excelsior

Note: Excelsior counts reflect students earning credits directly from Excelsior. They exclude 30,772 undergraduate students earning credits elsewhere.

UNDERGRADUATE

Enrolled in a 4- or 5-year bachelor's degree program, an associate's degree program, or a vocational or technical program below the baccalaureate level.

FIRST-TIME UNDERGRADUATE

An entering freshman who has never attended any college or other postsecondary institution. Includes students enrolled in the fall term who attended college for the first time in the prior summer term and students who entered with advanced standing (college credits earned before graduation from high school).

GRADUATE

Holding a bachelor's or first-professional degree, or equivalent, and taking courses at the post-baccalaureate level. Graduate students may or may not be enrolled in graduate programs (excluding first-professional programs).

FIRST-PROFESSIONAL STUDENT

Enrolled in any of the following degree programs: Chiropractic (D.C. or D.C.M.), Dentistry (D.D.S. or D.M.D.), Law (L.L.B., J.D.), Medicine (M.D.), Optometry (O.D.), Osteopathic Medicine (D.O.), Pharmacy (Pharm.D.), Podiatry (D.P.M., D.P., or Pod.D.), Theology (M.Div., M.H.L., B.D., or Ordination), Veterinary Medicine (D.V.M.).

FULL-TIME STUDENT

Undergraduate: Enrolled for 12 or more semester credits, or 12 or more quarter credits each term

Graduate: Enrolled for 9 or more semester or quarter credits each term, or preparing a thesis or dissertation and considered full-time by the institution

First-Professional, Full-Time Status: Defined by the institution

PART-TIME STUDENT

Undergraduate: Enrolled for 11 semester or quarter credits or less each term

Graduate: Enrolled for 8 semester or quarter credits or less, unless preparing a thesis (see definition of full-time)

First-Professional, Part-Time Status: Defined by the institution

FTE - FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT

Undergraduate: Full-time undergraduate + one-third part-time undergraduate

Graduate: Full-time graduate + .4 times part-time graduate

First-professional: Full-time First-professional + .4 times part-time First-professional




HIGHLIGHTS Fall 2008

Preliminary Degree-Credit Enrollment

- New York State enrolled 1.19 million degree-credit students in its 270 colleges regulated by the Board of Regents. Total enrollment increased 2.0%.
- Undergraduate enrollment increased 2.2% while graduate enrollment increased 1.1%. First-professional enrollment showed little change (+0.2%).
- Full-time, first-time enrollment increased 2.7%.

The State University of New York (SUNY) enrolled 36.8%, The City University of New York (CUNY) 20.4%, the independent colleges 38.9%, and the proprietary colleges 3.9% of all students. Overall, enrollment increased at SUNY (2.8%), CUNY (4.2%), and independent colleges (0.5%). Proprietary enrollment decreased 1.8%. Note that a proprietary college that closed* accounted for 5% of all enrollments in the sector.

- Of all students, 71.0% enrolled full-time, up slightly from 70.7%.
 - Program level shares changed only slightly. Undergraduate enrollment grew from 80.2% to 80.4% of all students. Graduate enrollment fell again this year from 16.9% to 16.8%. First-professional held stable at 2.8%.
 - 66.5% of undergraduates attended four-year and higher institutions. 29.3% of four-year undergraduates attended SUNY, 20.6% CUNY, 46.5% independent, and 3.6% proprietary colleges and universities.
 - Graduate student enrollment increased by 1.1%. The proprietary sector had a 9.1% increase, followed by CUNY with a 2.6% increase. SUNY and the independent colleges both increased only slightly (+0.7%). 18.1% of graduate students attended SUNY, 14.9% CUNY, 66.0% independent, and 1.0% proprietary colleges.
 - SUNY enrolled 65.9% of all undergraduates at two-year colleges, CUNY 25.4%, independent colleges 2.2%, and proprietary colleges 6.5%.
 - Undergraduate enrollment rose 1.6% in four-year and 3.5% in two-year colleges.

New York State 1980 to 2008**



New York State Total Degree-Credit Enrollment by Sector 1980 to 2008




