by Post-High School Plans

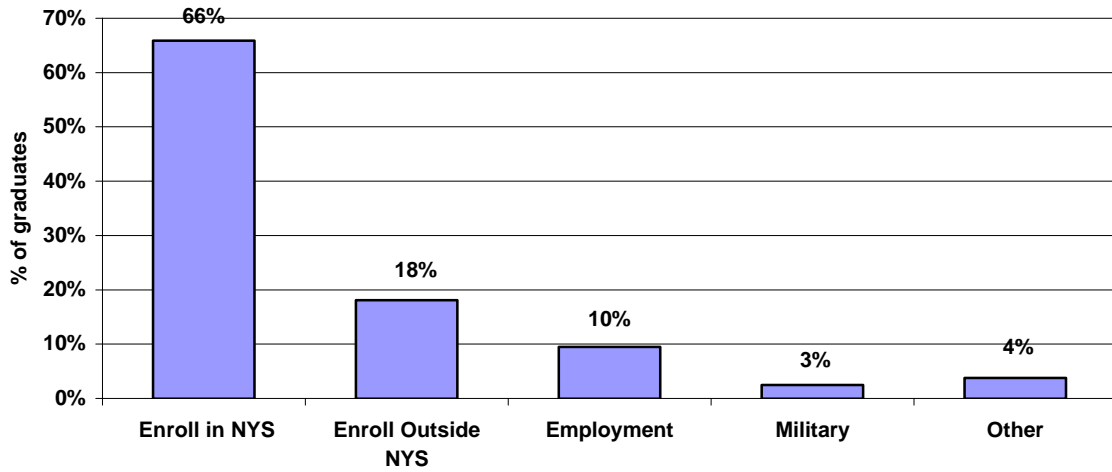

1969-70 to 1996-97

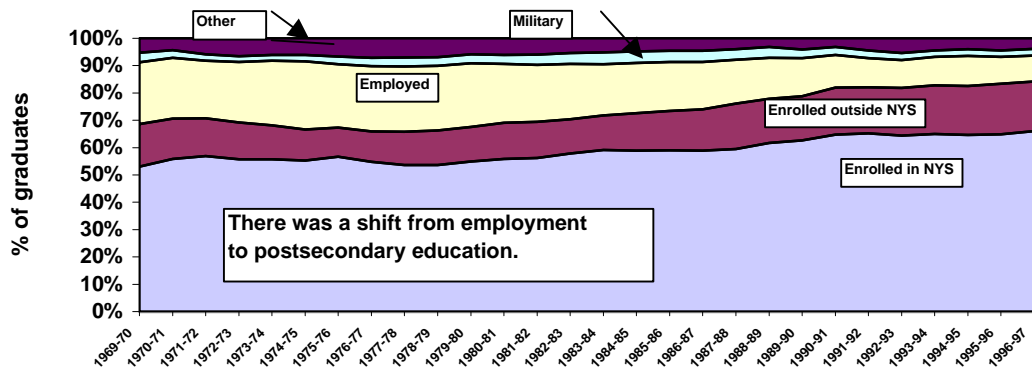

1969-70 to 1996-97

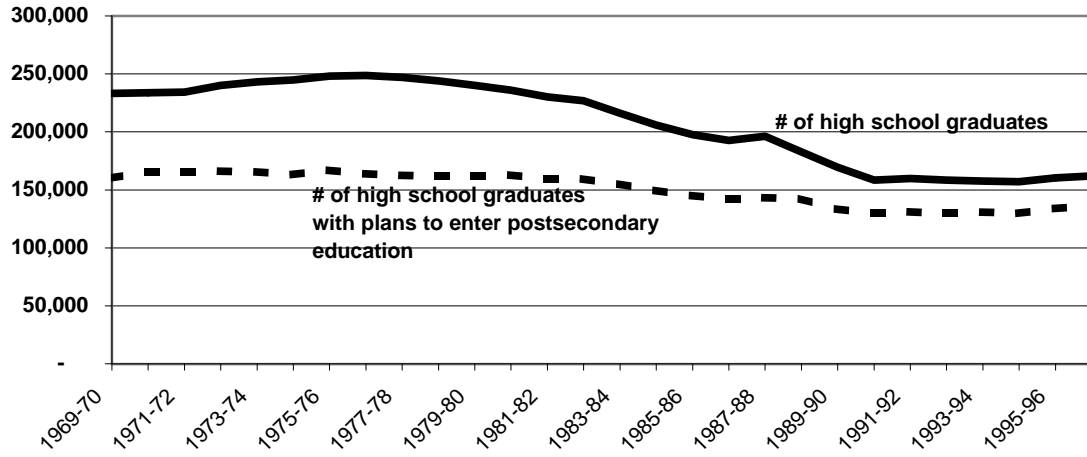

1969-70 to 1996-97

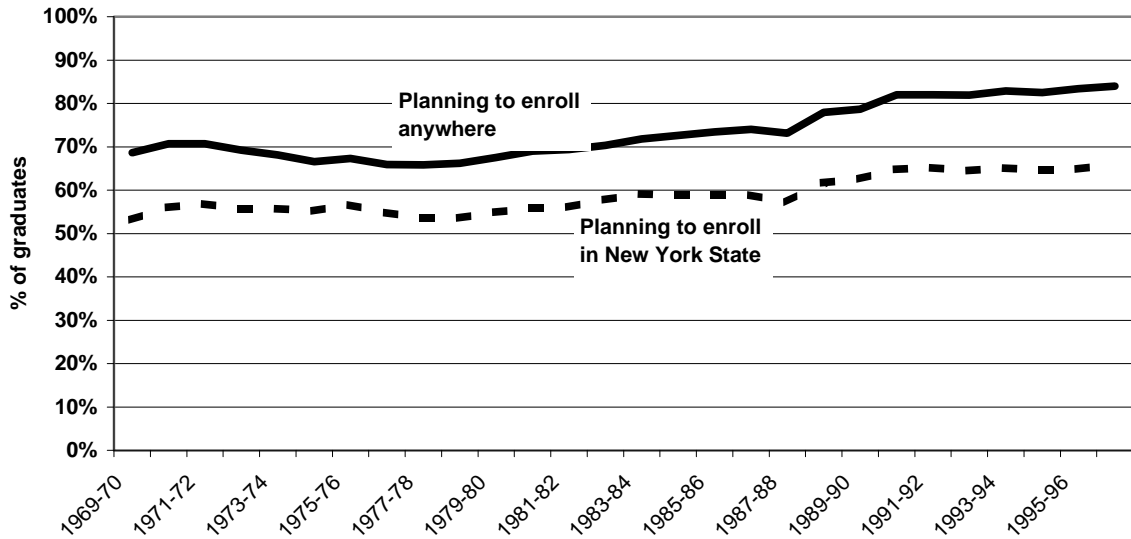

in College in Any Location by Race/Ethnicity, 1990-91 to 1996-97

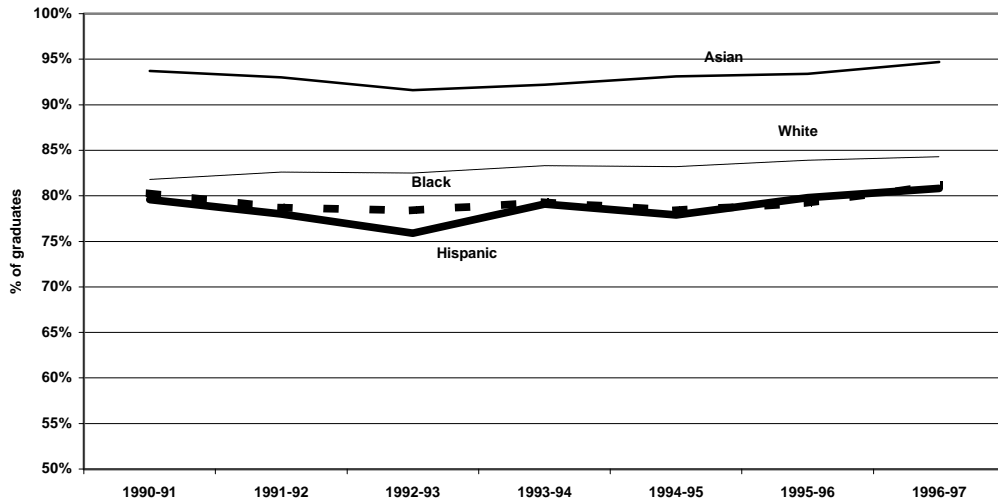

in College in New York State by Race/Ethnicity, 1990-91 to 1996-97

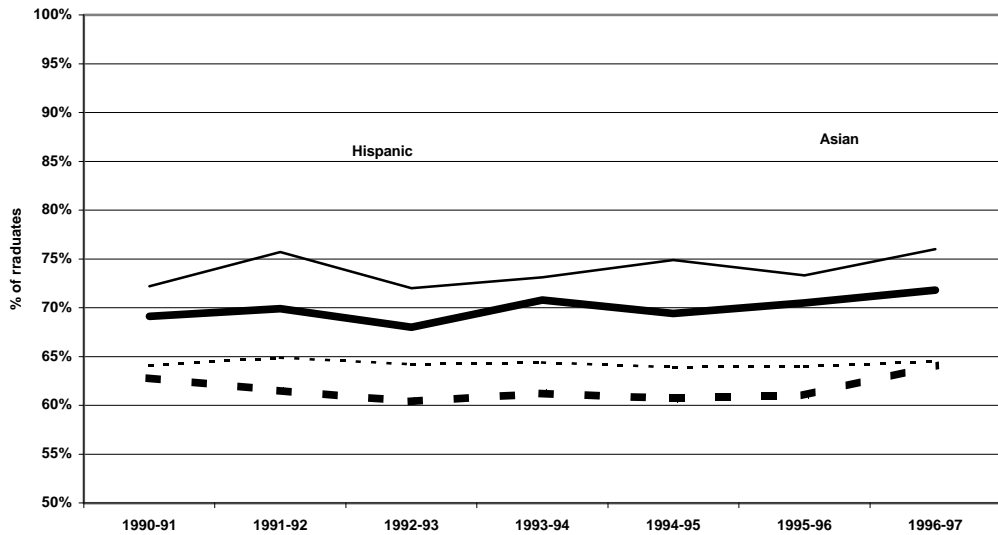
